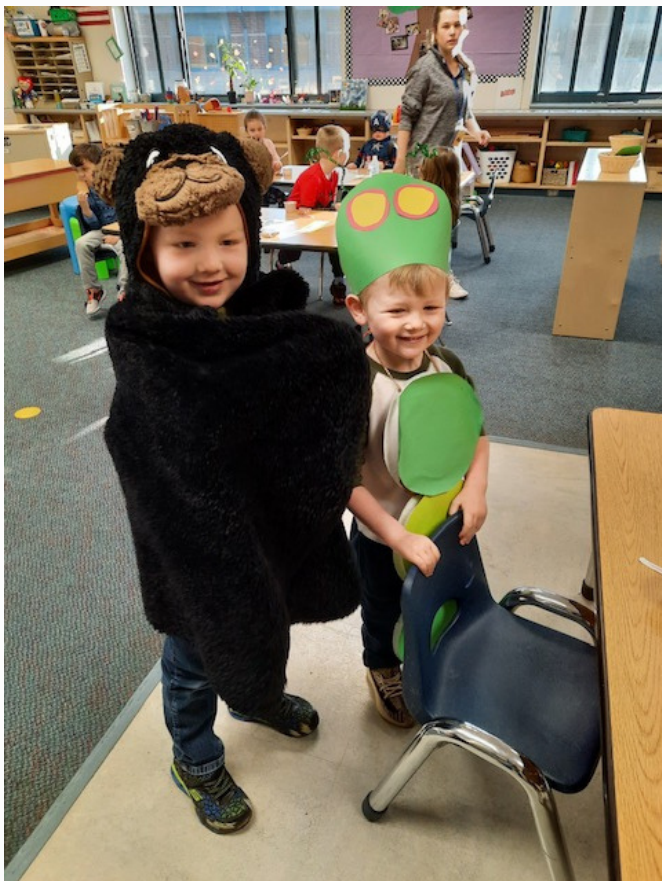
KINDERGARTEN ROUND-UP

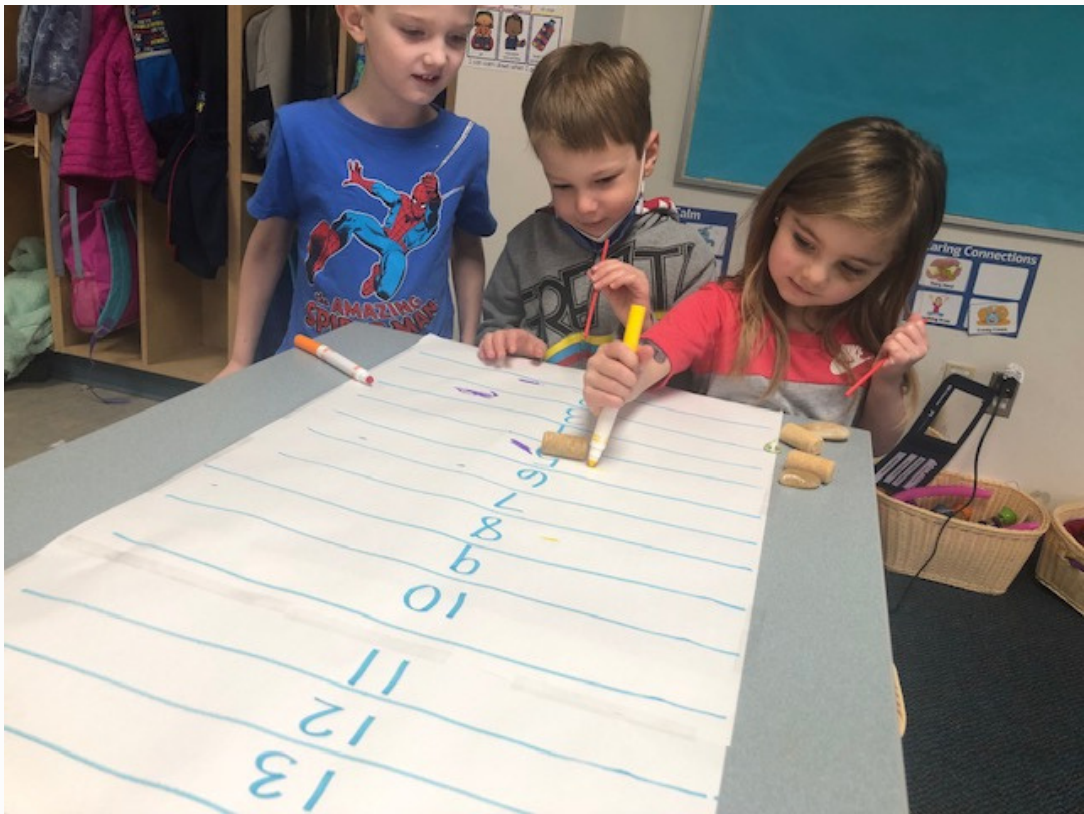
